Home Vegetable Gardening Tips & Techniques Seminar

Home gardening is an extremely popular activity, and is gaining even more interest for 2009, as families consider ways to cut their expenses. Growing some of your family's produce is often a great way to reduce food expense, have access to nutritious fruits and vegetables at their peak of flavor, as well as being a great family activity and free exercise.

If a new or expanded vegetable garden is in your plans, consider attending a free vegetable raising seminar being held at the Wild Rivers Interpretive Center on Thursday evening, April 16, starting at 7 p.m. This seminar is being sponsored by the Center and Florence County UW-Extension. Scott Reuss, Florence County UW-Extension Horticulture Agent, will be offering management tips and techniques that will help you along the way to a successful garden. He will talk about soil preparation and management, making those final selections on what to plant, and talk about some of the major pests your plants may encounter in their growth.
